



Ipswich Residential New Homes Program 2016 Project Application Form

Program Overview

Ipswich Municipal Light Department's Residential New Homes Program provides a home energy rating (HERS Index), and performance based incentives for new residential and multi-family buildings which are not eligible to participate in any other energy efficiency rebate programs.

The program fundamentally consists of three steps: First, applicants must submit the building plans for review. Plans are then reviewed by a RESNET-certified home energy rater (HERS rater) associated with the program and an energy rating analysis is conducted. At this point upgrade options may be recommended by the rater. The second and third steps involve site visits typically conducted 1) after insulation is installed and before drywall, and 2) when the home is complete and ready for move-in. The purpose of these site visits is to verify homes are built to the meet program compliance. Rebates will be offered to help offset the incremental cost of building a more efficient home and are structured on a scale such that more efficient home receives a higher rebate.

Eligible Projects

All residential new construction and gut-rehab projects in single-family and individually metered multi-family (2+ units) buildings (three stories or less) in the Ipswich service territory with other than natural gas heating.
